THE CARE PLANNING PROCESS

- Person-centered
- Agreed-upon goals
- Comprehensive assessment
- Involves the entire client/family system
- Addresses short-term needs: medical, social, safety, quality of life
- Addresses long-term needs: financial, legal, quality of life

ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF A PLAN OF CARE

- Demographics: emergency contacts, representatives
- Stated goals and timelines
- Medical history: physical, cognitive, mental health
- Social history
- Functional assessment: basic and instrumental activities of daily living
- Schedule of activities, which addresses:
 - Safety needs
 - Personal care needs
 - Household needs
 - Social needs: emotional, intellectual, spiritual

DEMENTIA AND SAFETY

- Judgment
- Memory loss
- Orientation to time and place
- Behavior
- Physical abilities
- Sensory changes

SAFETY: ADDRESSING MEDICAL CONCERNS

- Common comorbidities and complications
- Medication safety:
 - Compliance
 - Polypharmacy
 - Interactions
- Driving

SAFETY: ADDRESSING FINANCIAL CONCERNS

- Daily money management
- Mail handling
- Charitable giving
- Financial abuse

SAFETY: ADDRESSING SOCIAL CONCERNS

- Household safety
- Wandering
- Social isolation
- Intellectual engagement
- Undue influence

SAFETY: ADDRESSING LEGAL CONCERNS

- Advanced health care directive planning
- Durable powers of attorney
- Guardianship and conservatorship
